We'd really like to get you involved in the project launch event that will be taking place around the 19-20 May.

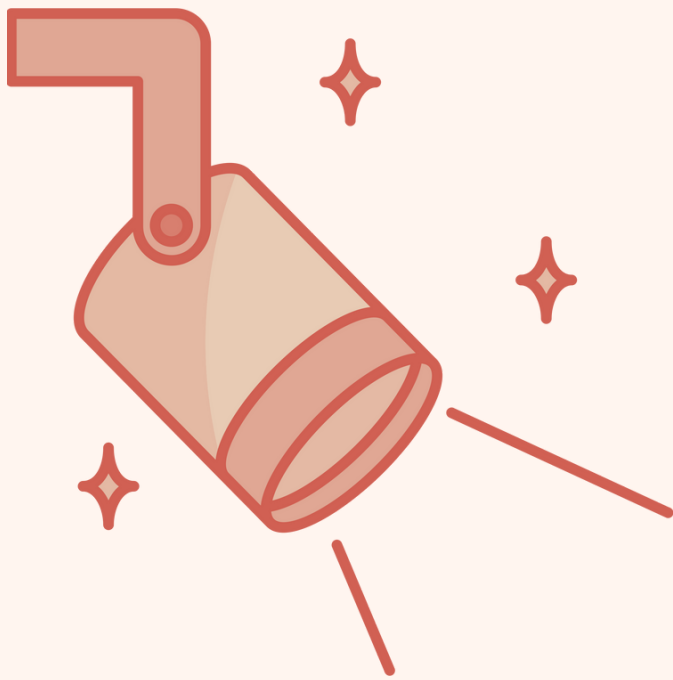
